Head Unexplained seizure(s) Unexplained chronic headache where significant pathology is suspected Spine (after an x-ray has been performed) Unexplained back pain where significant pathology is suspected Unexplained neck or back pain with associated neurological signs Significant trauma Hip (after an x-ray has been performed) Suspected septic arthritis Suspected slipped femoral capital epiphysis Suspected Perthes disease Elbow (after an x-ray has been performed)

Suspected significant fracture or avulsion injury, that will change management
